Working with the Cleft lip and Palate Association (CLAPA), you will be hosting Baby Sign Language Courses over Zoom.

Key tasks may include:

- Create a session plan or follow the session plan provided
- Meet with facilitators and/or CLAPA staff 15 minutes ahead of session
- Ensure safeguarding procedures are followed
- Run through introductions and basic Zoom housekeeping
- Lead attendees through a range of topics, teaching baby sign language over an hour session as part of a short course
- End the zoom meeting, sharing any relevant upcoming events
- Complete analysis of session and share feedback with your CLAPA contact
- Adhere to CLAPA policies/procedures as discussed in Volunteer Host induction
